## **IMPRESSIONS OF FASCIST ITALIA BY THE TURKISH ELİTES DURING 1930'S**

### **Abstract:**

The 1930's had witnessed the waves of fascism all around the world, especially in Europe. Turkish administrative formation in 1930's was similar with the administrative formats emerged in south eastern Europe; including in Salazar, Portugal, in Franco, Spain, and Metax, Greece. Although there were important differences between the case of Turkey and the fascist examples in Europe; a fascist example in Italy, was so significant for the Turkish ruling elites with no doubt. For instances, some of the laws enacted at 1930's were the copies of Italian laws.
