VALUES AND MODEL ROLES OF MODERN RUSSIAN YOUTH IN THE CONTEXT OF POST-INDUSTRIAL SOCIALITY

Abstract:

On the basis of the scientific literature post-industrial sociality key characteristics associated with the central role of an independent and purposeful person, the article reveals the degree of autonomy in the implementation of its own life strategy and focus on improving their "Knowledge" potential as well as the main tendencies of forming the system of life values of Russian students.
